**Objective**

To provide financial assistance to academically successful second, third, and fourth year college students pursuing an Associate Degree, Bachelor's Degree, Technical or Vocational Certification.

**Amount and Disbursement of Scholarships**

Four \$2,000.00 scholarships will be awarded. One half of the annual scholarship or \$1,000.00 will be made available to the student prior to the beginning of the fall semester, upon receipt of proof of enrollment, full-time student status, and verification of a cumulative grade point average of 2.5. The second half of the scholarship or \$1,000.00 will be made available upon receipt of proof of enrollment for the spring semester, verification of full-time student status, and transcript verifying that the student achieved a grade point average of 2.5 or better for the fall semester. A full-time student is classified as one carrying 12 hours or more for the entire semester. *Scholarship funds not disbursed prior to the first day of class each semester will be forfeited.*

**Type and Location of School**

The scholarship can be used for any educational institution of higher learning. This will include any junior college, college, university, technical or vocational school.

**Qualification Criteria**

The recipient must be an active member, or the dependent of an active member of Dell Telephone Cooperative, Inc. An active member is defined as a subscriber in good standing, receiving local service/dial tone from a Dell Telephone exchange as of December 1, 2006.

**Scholarship Application**

Completed scholarship applications must be submitted to Dell Telephone Cooperative Education Foundation, Attn: Susan Barker, 610 South Main, P.O. Box 678, Dell City, TX 79837, on or before July 10, 2007. - ✓ Applicant must be an active member or a dependent of an active member receiving service from Dell Telephone Cooperative, Inc. An active member is defined as a subscriber in good standing, receiving local service/dial tone from a Dell Telephone Exchange as of December 1, 2006.
- ✓ Applicant must use scholarship to attend an accredited junior college, college, university, technical or vocational school on a full time basis, carrying a minimum of 12 hours from one institution.
- ✓ Applicant must have a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 or equivalent on a 4.0 scale.
- ✓ Applicant must have graduated from high school in 2004, 2005 or 2006.
- ✓ Applicant must submit **completed application and certification, official college transcript, two-page essay, Educator's Recommendation, and one letter of recommendation**, (not from an educator).
- ✓ Please note: **Educator's Recommendation and letter of recommendation must be mailed directly to the Cooperative.**
- ✓ **Essay Requirements: In a two-page essay, describe: your educational and career goals and where you expect to be ten years from now.**
- ✓ **Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.**
